

SCTS Education Ethicon Trainee Fellowship 2017

SCTS Education in partnership with Ethicon is pleased to announce the 2017 SCTS Education Ethicon Trainee Fellowships for senior national trainees.

It is the sixth year of this highly successful programme, with previous awardees having gone on to consultant positions following completion of their fellowship and CCT. The fellowships will be awarded for a designated period of six months to senior trainees who have not yet secured a consultant post.

Appropriate criteria are:

- An opportunity to be the primary operator during the 6-month attachment
- Full involvement in pre-operative evaluation and post-operative care
- An Education Learning Agreement
- A mentor based in the UK
- A supernumerary post

The trainee should go to a unit in or outside of the UK which has a strong training ethos and is able to offer an experience which will enhance the CV / experience to a significant extent and facilitate in success of the applicant in getting a consultant post. These positions must be started within 12 months of the award of the fellowship. Trainees are advised to make arrangements for applying through the deanery for recognition of Out of Programme Training at the same time as applying for this fellowship.

Trainees *must* be members of SCTS to be eligible.

Please send an application with the following details:

- Brief CV (Maximum 2 pages)
- Details of the fellowship with provisional approval from the visiting centre
- Fellowship subspecialty, e.g. minimally invasive cardiac, thoracic, transplant
- Operative experience in last 2 years
- Letter of support from Programme Director or Chair of STC
- Confirmation of SCTS membership
