

Marian and Christina Ionescu Consultant Travelling Fellowship 2017

SCTS Education is pleased to announce a consultant fellowship of £10,000 to facilitate professional development of a consultant colleague member of SCTS.

The fellowship is awarded annually and the selection process is managed by SCTS Education. The fellowship can be utilised for an individual or a team to facilitate Service, Leadership, Management, Education or Academic Development. The fellowship should bring value to the consultant colleague, team, organisation and the cardiothoracic specialty. All subspecialty consultant members of SCTS are eligible to apply.

Applications will be assessed by the SCTS education committee. Applications should include the following:

- Brief CV (1 -2 page only)
- Description of the project or fellowship and how will it help the patients, organization, team, and individual
- Approximate costs
- Provisional acceptance from the visiting centre
- Letter of support from the clinical director and departmental lead

Successful applicants will be expected to submit a report to SCTS Education and will be announced at the SCTS Annual Meeting in Belfast (12-14 March 2017).
